When Dr. Nina Schoch volunteered in 1998 to help collect the first blood and feather samples from Adirondack loons, she never thought 26 years later that this initial research would evolve into an independent nonprofit organization. Today, the Adirondack Center for Loon Conservation is thrilled to announce a pivotal juncture in its continued journey towards sustained growth and excellence with the initiation of its strategic succession plan. After more than 25 years of studying loons in the Adirondacks, Dr. Nina Schoch, the Center's Executive Director, looks forward to transitioning into a new role as our Director of Science and Conservation.



Our succession plan will fortify the leadership structure, streamline operations for the future, and continue the expansion of our scientific research, educational programs, and management efforts to better protect Adirondack loons and the waters where they live. As one of the leading organizations in the Adirondacks devoted to wildlife health and conservation, our scientific and conservation efforts have provided many contributions to the scientific and public communities, including:

- Monitoring trends in the Adirondack loon population and reproductive success for over 25 years
- Improved management and protection of loon nest sites leading to increased hatching success of loon nests
- Assessing the health of Adirondack loons through sample and carcass collection to determine their exposure to environmental toxins, parasites, and avian diseases
- Publishing numerous scientific and lay articles to inform policy-makers and the public about threats affecting wildlife and the environment
- Inspiring community and student engagement in environmental conservation through our education programs
